

PRINCE RIVER WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA

(Barre)

SIZE: Prince River WMA is composed of two parcels of mostly hilly terrain totaling 690 acres. U.S.G.S. Quad: Barre

VEGETATION: This area is dominated by mixed hardwood and conifer forest interspersed with wooded swamps.

WATER: Both sections of the area encompass portions of the Prince River, a stocked trout water, as well as a few native brook trout streams which are tributaries of the river.

WILDLIFE: Grouse, woodcock, deer, coyote, snowshoe hare, turkey, gray squirrel, raccoon and numerous nongame species. This area is **not** stocked with pheasant.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS: None.
