

## HUBBARDSTON WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA

(Hubbardston)

SIZE:	600 acres of hills and valleys leased from the Metropolitan District Commission. Access and parking off New Westminster Road and Westminster Road. U.S.G.S. Quads: Fitchburg, Sterling
VEGETATION:	Mixed hardwood and conifer forest interspersed with agricultural and brushy fields with some alder and grass hummock marshes.
WATER:	Cunningham Pond and a portion of Joslin Brook is stocked with trout, and bordered in places by marshland.
WILDLIFE:	Stocked pheasant, snowshoe hare, cottontail rabbit, gray squirrel, woodcock, deer, turkey, red and gray fox, waterfowl and numerous nongame species.

## SPECIAL

REGULATIONS: Note that a "hunter orange" hat is required wear for hunters during the pheasant season.
